The History of the area...



For centuries, Native Americans hunted and lived in the hills and valleys that comprise the area now known as Singing Hills. After California's state-hood, the property was sold to a ranch family who developed a vineyard and winery having secured choice vines from Europe's finest vineyards. In 1884 the "White House" was built using rock blasted from the northern hills. It was when these rocks were blasted that one could hear seven distinct echoes from which the name "Singing Hills" was derived. (This same rock was used later in the construction of the original clubhouse, which has been preserved as the interior walls found in Echo's dining room and lounge.) With the advent of prohibition, the vineyards were torn out and olive groves planted. Slips, or cuttings, were taken from the original San Diego Mission olive trees brought over from Spain by the missionaries. The original plantings are still in the areas around the Lodge and golf courses. In 1955 the property was obtained by four families dedicated to the preservation of the land. The Singing Hills Resort & Golf Club was thus born. San Diego Magazine selected Singing Hills Resort as one of the most beautiful settings in San Diego County.



about San Diego

San Diego is a natural choice for golfers who desire a moderate winter climate. Unlike the desert climate of Phoenix, Las Vegas or Palm Springs which are given to huge climate swings in the winter, San Diego's ocean influence keeps temperatures moderate nearly all the time—daytime highs in the winter rarely dip below 65 or go above 75.

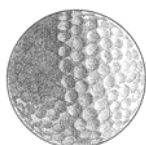
